Following **Yes Network** with 12 Awards were **MSG** and **WCBS-TV**, each winning 10 New York Emmy® Awards.

WCBS-TV’s CBS2 11 PM Newscast took home the Emmy® for best “Evening Newscast (Under 35 Minutes)” for its **May 30, 2008** broadcast.

WCBS-TV’s CBS2 5 PM Newscast took home the Emmy® for best “Evening Newscast (Over 35 minutes)” for its story **Midtown Crane Collapse**.
